



Motion Regarding the Submission of Councillor Reports to AUS

WHEREAS, according to the AUS Constitution (Article 2.1) the AUS exists to enhance the welfare of its constituents through the promotion of their interests, as well as through services designed to improve their social, educational, and cultural conditions;

WHEREAS, departmental associations represent students registered in specific academic programs, and thus exist to advocate for their respective interests to the AUS;

WHEREAS, departmental associations receive funding from the AUS and thus should be held accountable to their mandate;

WHEREAS, the Students Society of McGill University has set a precedent by enforcing the submission of bi-weekly councillor reports;

BE IT RESOLVED, that AUS councillors send in bi-weekly reports on the activities of their associations to the Speaker of AUS Council;

BE IT RESOLVED, that each Departmental association report verbally to AUS Council once per semester, coming into force Winter 2016;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the failure to submit reports biweekly be equivalent to an absence at AUS Council and be subject to the same consequences up to, and including suspension of funding;
