



Motion to Amend the ASEF Bylaws

Whereas, the ASEF is funded partially by students in the Faculty of Arts.

Whereas, the ASEF allows a substantial amount of students to be hired by professors and various units within McGill.

Whereas, the AUS seeks to promote transparency and accountability in its practices and in the services it offers; and there has been a lack of transparency in tracking ASEF reports, as well as insufficient information provided in the received reports.

Whereas, the distribution of ASEF funding requires invaluable coordination with the Office for Graduate Studies & Research.

Be it resolved, the AUS Council approves the addition of the following points to the ASEF Bylaws,

4.6 Students with ASEF funded positions, whether designated or undesignated, must submit a brief report to the Vice-President Academic within one month of the completion of their project

4.6.1 Reports should outline the following:

- brief overview of the project
- Students' role in the project
- impact of the project, particularly on Arts undergraduate students, and future plans for the project

4.6.2 Reports should include the amount of money paid to the student, including how it was paid (lump sum payment or per hour payment), and the total hours worked on the project
