



## Motion to Endorse the Survivor Support Letter

**Whereas**, article 1.2 of the AUS Equity Policy states that: “the AUS strives to create a community that exceeds social standards of equitable treatment, creating a safer space for all of our members”;

**Whereas**, article 1.5 of the AUS Equity Policy states that: “the AUS condemns harassment or discrimination of disadvantaged groups on the basis of, but not limited to, gender identity, age, race, ethnic or national origin, religion, sexuality, sexual orientation, mental and/or physical abilities, language, size, or social class. The AUS regards harassment or discrimination on the basis of these considerations as serious offences that undermine its constitutional commitment to respect”;

**Whereas**, the attached letter has been drafted in consultation with the SUS and other faculty associations on campus;

**Whereas**, the attached letter is the result of weeks of consultations regarding how best to support survivors with stakeholder groups on campus;

**Whereas**, the McGill administration should be doing more to support survivors;
