



Report of Economics Students' Association

1. ESA Economics Department Survey

- The survey is intended to find out the economics students' general opinion about the economics major program overall.
- It contains the opinion-based questions about the potential math requirements for the program, additional programming courses for economic analysis, difficulty of the current math level, etc.
- The ESA has completed the final report about the results (126 respondents total).
- We will be discussing the report with Prof. Galbraith (Chair of Economics Department) and Prof. Dickinson on Wednesday, March 14th.
- Depends on the result of the report, the economics department may discuss the issues in the committee meeting to consider academic revisions of the economics major program.

2. Guest Speaker Series

- The ESA Guest Speaker, Sylvain Leduc (Deputy Governor at Bank of Canada) has confirmed his participation in the event.
- The event will take its place on 23rd of March from 6 pm to 9 pm in the Faculty Club.
- The ESA will request the Departmental Fund + Arts Supplementary Fund.
- The expense for the Faculty Club (Room Booking + Wine + Snacks + AV Set + Bartender) will be 5,491.15, under the assumption that \$2,000 of Arts Supplementary Fund is approved. – We will try to reduce the cost in case \$2,000 is not possible.
- Additional expenses (gift for the speaker, drink coupons for the speaker & staff, pamphlets) will be dealt with after the event.

3. ESA Clothing Sale

- The supplies are expected to arrive here by the last week of March.
- So far, we have generated \$2,430 of revenue. – Please note that additional \$120 revenue will be deposited as deferred payments later this month. – Hence, the total revenue at the end will be $\$2,430 + \$120 = \$2,550$
- The total cost for the sale is \$2,185.67.
- The ESA will deposit the revenue and request a cheque for the expenses to the FMC by this week.
