Initial Notes

- Five executive meetings have been held so far;
- Alerted on 26 September that the **Faculty of Arts is cutting the major, honours and joint honours** programs for Canadian Studies! Minor will continue, but all other programs will end in the next 3 years, as declared students graduate
 - Still working on finding the best method to announce to CANS students
- Jointly-held event with QSSA at the Chateau Ramezay happening on November 10 - initial planning/tickets have been readied, ticket sales to begin on Monday, October 15th
- Executive photos have been taken - photographer is contracted for the completed pictures to be sent by 28 October

Upcoming

 - Will help to ensure stable funding and expectations when planning events throughout the year
- VP Events working to plan out smaller, more frequent events throughout the year
