



Report of Arts Senator **Henrique Mecabô** to Legislative Council

Late October

- I. McGill Senate:
 - a. McGill Senate met on last Wednesday, October 23rd, notably discussing the question wrote by myself and other student Senators on “Made by McGill,” the University Advancement annual report and issues of student conduct and discipline
 - i. In light of the issue raised about “Made by McGill” not having funds obviously devoted to Student Services (which include the Student Wellness Hub), the Vice Principal, University Advancement agreed to work more closely with students to get input on what funds raised from donations should be directed to, making sure the McGill community can be engaged in fundraising efforts and, therefore, making donations more appealing to donors. Changes to the campaign website will also be considered.
 - ii. Fabrice Labeau (Deputy Provost, Student Life and Learning) promised to provide clarifying information on how the funds donated by the Rossy Foundation to build the Student Wellness Hub were used and funneled to Student Services
 - b. The McGill Association of University Teachers (MAUT) received student senators to discuss documents that would be presented at the Senate meeting
- II. The project of reviewing the University Student Assessment Policy will move forward with a sentiment survey to be sent to students across campus on how they feel about the manners in which they are evaluated and in which their needs are accommodated. In parallel, the SSMU Student Rights Researcher & Advocacy Commissioner will research assessment policies at “peer institutions.”
- III. Attended the university’s Fall Convocation Ceremony on Tuesday, October 29th.
